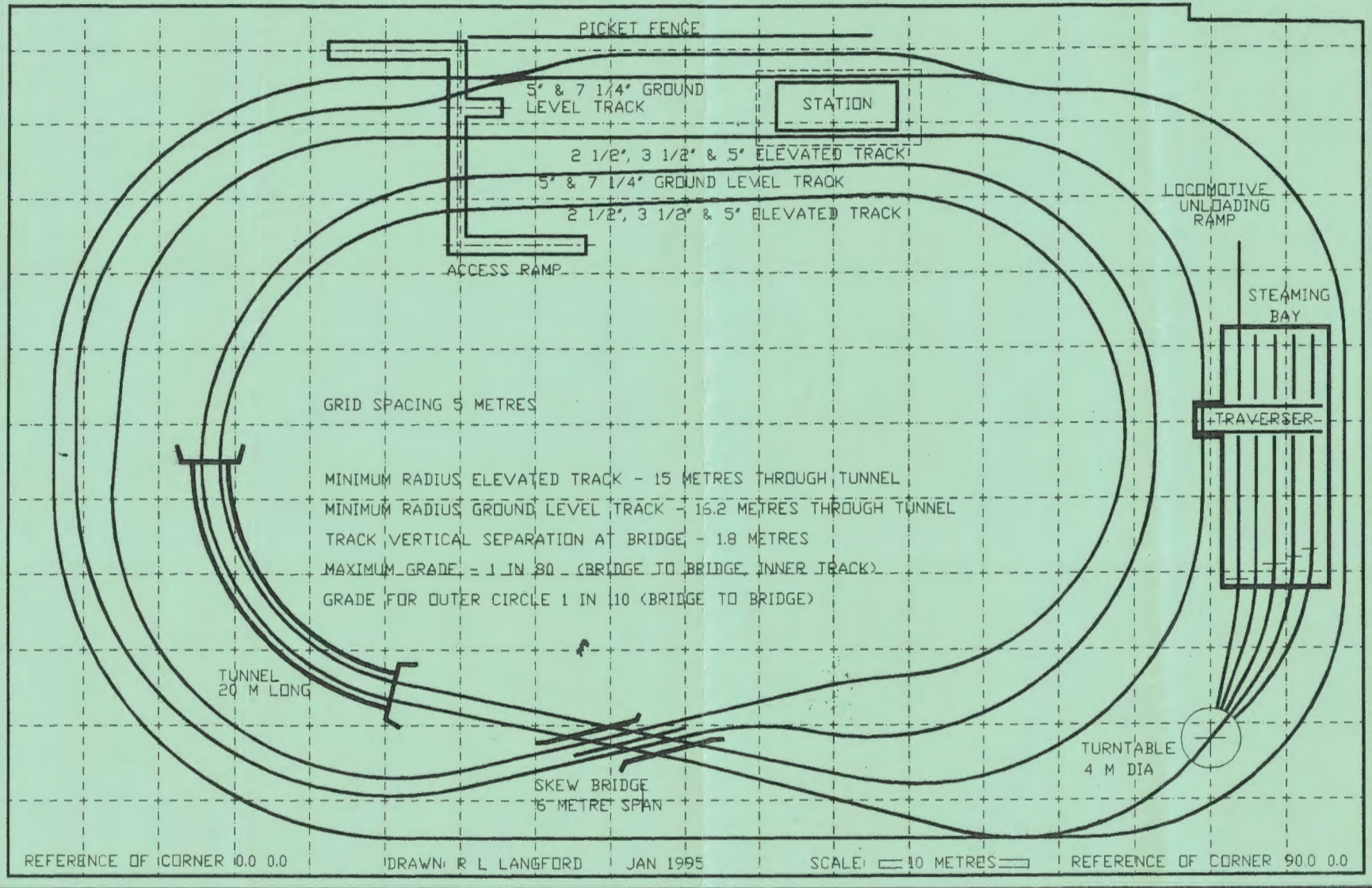

At the February, 1995 meeting we had several visitors to our Club, namely Gordon Searle and Hal Cooper. It was revealed that members and visitors were making good progress with their own individual projects, some of which are recorded hereunder:-

Doug Baker gave a report on his Steam Truck, brakes all done, plumbing all done, Body painted. Hopes to have it running this year. Is pleased with his progress so far.

Is working on a 3 pendulum harmonograph which will be used at Special Run Days etc. Is also progressing with his 24' Steam Boat.

Ken Dines brought along and gave a talk on his 5" super simplex which he has been manufacturing over the last 2½ years. He was elated when he was able to turn it by hand with only minimal tight spots and hopes to run it on air soon.

Geoffrey Evelyn reported that he had completed the frames (engine and tender) and one driving wheel was half completed for his 7¼" Stirling Single Wheeler. The driving wheel is approximately 13" in diameter.

Dick Langford provided an update of our Track Site with a computer printout using "Auto Sketch" package which incorporates the plans for our 7¼" ground level track etc. (copy attached)

Jack Laughlin manufactured a hand wheel for Lathe vertical slide. He showed an internal screw cutting tool and displayed a Collett that he had manufactured and,

John Martin showed and talked about a boring bar tool post manufactured for his Myford Lathe.

Gordon Searle gave an informative talk on the building on his full size model steam car. So far has had it running on air.
